What is Rooted?

Rooted is a small group experience created by Mariner's Church in Irvine, CA in partnership with church leaders from around the world including the Pacific Southwest District of the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod (of which we are a part)

What is Rooted Like?

Rooted is designed to transform lives and habits. This is not an information or membership class. Rooted believes in "hand's on" learning. Families will be changed through praying, learning and serving together.

What Happens at the End?

At the completion of the 10 week course, families are invited to stay in touch and meet as a small group. Those who have not been Confirmed or Baptized may request this. Baptisms and Confirmation will occur on Easter.
